New Information

- **Let's practice Social Distancing to let our kids return to school!**
- **New Confirmed Case**
 - Incheon patient #46, living in Namdong-gu, returned to Korea on Mar. 20, while in student exchange program in the US (all 4 close contact people tested 'negative')
 - Incheon patient #47, living in Bupyeong-gu, contact person (co-worker) of the confirmed in Seoul
- **2 more patients discharged from hospital after recovery**
 - Incheon patient #14 and #19 living in Bupyeong-gu, workers of the call center in Geumcheon-gu, Seoul

Incheon's Response Measures

- **Conduct survey on Incheon citizens who entered Korea from Europe and the Americas between March 2 and 21 (please call your local public health center or Incheon city call center on 032-120)**
 - ⊗ **Voluntary report and test by travelers from overseas (entered on Mar. 2-22):**
 - 337 in total (6 confirmed)
 - ⊗ **From March. 22, pre-emptive testing is underway for the entrants from Europe and the Americas**
- **Provide emergency support (worth KRW 122.2 billion) for households with less than 100% of median income, non-standard contracted workers (incl. freelancers) and people on unpaid leave**
