## COVID-19 Responses Incheon Daily Report

## **New Information**

- (6 May) Regarding the new confirmed case who visited clubs in Itaewon, Seoul.
- (Late night to early morning of 7-8 May) All 8 Incheon citizens who voluntarily reported to have visited the above clubs tested 'negative'
  - \*1 contact of the confirmed case, 6 other club visitors, 1 contact of the visitor
- No Incheon citizen is included in the 43 workplace contacts of the confirmed case of Yongin who are required to be under self-quarantine
  - (Morning of 8 May) 1 new confirmed case who visited clubs in Itaewon
    - \*living in Bupyeong-gu, Seoul's tally
    - \*Tested at screening clinic of Gwanak-gu Public Health Center, Seoul)
- \*Urgently transferred to the Incheon Medical Center with the person's contacts (3 family members) having tested
- If you visited clubs in Itaewon on 2 May such as King Club (00:00-03:30), Trunk (01:00-01:40), and Queen (03:30-03:50), please visit the nearest public health center.
- Preemptive testing for high-risk groups continues to prepare for any resurgence of COVID-19
  - about 500 tests a day
- 'Free Outreach Check-up Service' for those in the blind spots of healthcare services
  - For foreign workers, homeless persons, Jjok-bang (dosshouse) residents, etc.
- Visited by a Testing team (medical professional, civil servant, driver, interpreter)

No new confirmed cases in Incheon for the third consecutive day

- Three discharged from hospital: Incheon Patient #20, #67, #71
- The number of secondary and tertiary transmissions: 12 out of 97 (12.4%)
- No community transmission since 15 April!
- No cluster infection in Incheon!
